2. Which of your data are processed by us? And for what purposes?

We process the data that you have sent us in connection with your application in order to check your suitability for the position (or other open positions in our companies, if applicable) and to carry out the application procedure.

3. What is the legal basis for this?

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data in this application procedure is primarily § 26 BDSG in the version valid from 25.05.2018. According to this, the processing of data required in connection with the decision to establish an employment relationship is permissible.

Should the data be necessary for legal prosecution after the application procedure has been completed, data processing may be carried out based on the requirements of Art. 6 DSGVO, in particular to safeguard legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 letter f) DSGVO. Our interest then consists in the assertion or defence of claims.

4. How long is the data stored?

Data of applicants will be deleted after 6 months in case of a rejection.

If you have been awarded a job during the application procedure, the data will be transferred to our personnel information system.

5. To which recipients will the data be passed on?

Your applicant data will be viewed by the personnel department after receipt of your application. Suitable applications are then forwarded internally to the departmental managers responsible for the vacant position in question.

6. Where is the data processed?
